Announcement

Reopening of the 30-year 1.80 % Green Federal bond of 2023 (2053)

As already announced in the issuance calendar for the first quarter of 2025, the Federal Government will reopen once again the

1.80 % Green bond of the Federal Republic of Germany of 2023 (2053)

issued on 13 June 2023 - ISIN DE0001030757

on 25 February 2025, using an auction procedure. An increase of € 1.5 billion is envisaged for the issue (auction allotment and amount set aside for secondary market operations). The current volume of the bond amounts to € 9.5 billion. Members of the Bund Issues Auction Group are entitled to bid.

Bidding period:	Tuesday, 25 February 2025, from 8.00 a.m. until 11.30 a.m. Frankfurt time
Inclusion in stock exchange trading:	Tuesday, 25 February 2025

Terms of the issue to be reopened:

Maturity:	15 August 2053
Interest date:	15 August annually
Stripping:	Stripping is not possible
